LOCAL RULES

These specific local rules ccomplement the permanent local rules of the French Golf Federation and cancel all other local rules.

Integral parts of the course

- All paths and rocks.
- Wood chips and stones on paths are loose impediments.

Abnormal course conditions R-16:

- The stones lining the path behind hole n°9 are immovable obstructions (the path itself is an integral part of the course and the stones are loose impediments.)
- If a player's ball lies in the general area in a zone cut to fairway height or less and there is interference by exposed tree roots, the player may take relief without penalty according to R16.1b.

BUT relief is not available if the tree roots are in the rough or only interfere with the player's stance.

Clean the ball - Local rule type E-2:

Model local rule E-2 is in effect: When a player's ball lies in the
general area cut to fairway height or less, the ball may be lifted,
cleaned and replaced without penalty. The player must mark the spot
of the ball before lifting it and the ball must be replaced on its original
spot.

Attention:

 The maximum allowed playing time is 3H46 for 2-ball matches and 4H30 for 4-ball matches.

A referee will be assigned to each match.

Clean the ball - Local rule type E-2:

Model local rule E-2 is in effect: When a player's ball lies in the
general area cut to fairway height or less, the ball may be lifted,
cleaned and replaced without penalty. The player must mark the spot
of the ball before lifting it and the ball must be replaced on its original
spot.

Attention:

 The maximum allowed playing time is 3H46 for 2-ball matches and 4H30 for 4-ball matches.

A referee will be assigned to each match.
