## **COUPE MOUCHY 2026**

**ELITE MEN'S GRAND PRIX**

**Qualifying round : *Coupe Patrick Frayssineau***

### **Event rules**

**These regulations are supplemented by the general regulations for French federal amateur events.**

#### **Article 1 - GAME FORMULA**

##### **Coupe Patrick FRAYSSINEAU**

Qualifying event for the Coupe MOUCHY open to amateur players licensed with the Fédération Française de Golf or licensed with a recognized foreign federation, within the index limits set in article 2 of these rules.

Stroke-Play : 18 holes on Friday, April 24, 2026

18 holes Saturday, April 25, 2026

No play-off for 1st place. The tie will be decided by the score of the last round, followed by 9, 6, 3 and the last hole, then if there is still a tie, hole by hole going backwards.

The top 39 finishers and ties will qualify for the **Coupe MOUCHY**.

##### **Coupe MOUCHY**

Reserved for the first 39 and ex-aequo of the **Coupe Patrick FRAYSSINEAU**.

Stroke Play formula: 36 holes on Sunday April 26, 2026

Ranking based on 72-hole total.

A play-off will be played on Sunday April 26, 2026 at the end of the event to decide between ex-aequo for first place, on the 1st, 18th, 10th and 9th holes. If the play-off cannot be completed or played, the tie will be broken on the basis of the score of the last round, then the 9th, 6th, 3rd and last holes, then if the tie remains, hole by hole going backwards.

#### **Article 2 - SERIES, TEES MARKS AND NUMBER OF PLAYERS**

One Men's series - Index limited to 4.4 - Tees marks : Back tee

The total number of entries will be limited to 132 :

- 7 wild-cards designated by the club
- 3 wild-cards designated by the FFGolf National Technical Department.
- 3 wild-cards designated by the Paris-Ile-de-France League.

**13** places for U16 French Gold licences that do not qualify via their amateur merit place or their index. Places will be allocated according to the same criteria as the official list. A U16 player holding a French Gold licence does not have to have the required index to be included in the quota.

Then **106** players will be selected, with priority being given first to those ranked in the top 2,500 of the WAGR, then to those ranked in order of French National Amateur Merit, and then to those ranked in order of index, on the closing date for registrations.

The index limit does not apply to players ranked in the top 2,500 of the WAGR or players ranked in the Mérite National Amateur.

### **Article 3 - THE PLAYER - Non-smoking event**

The player must meet all the following criteria:

- Be a member of the Fédération Française de Golf and have paid the “droit de jeu fédéral” or be a member of a recognized foreign federation.
- Be up to date with entry fees for all previous Grand Prix events
- Meet all sporting entry criteria
- Hold a medical certificate stating that they are fit to play golf in a competition dating from 2024 or 2025.
- For players not licensed in France, a medical certificate must be provided at the time of registration, and, fill in the health questionnaire found on the ffgolf website.
- The licence and medical certificate must be registered with the ffgolf before the start of the competition, otherwise the player's score will be blocked on RMS.

### **Article 4 - COMMITMENT FEES (the training day on Thursday, April 24, 2025 is included)**

### **Article 5 - CLOSING OF COMMITMENTS: Thursday, April 10, 2025 at 12 p.m.**

Any player who withdraws after the registration deadline remains liable for the entry fee.

- Only the date of receipt of registrations will be taken into account in drawing up the official list.
- The list of selected players will be published on Monday, 13 April 2026 at 12 noon.

### **Article 8 - DRAWING OF TEETIMES**

Tee times will be from hole 1 and hole 10 beginning at 8:00am.

The 1st round will be teed off in time slots, with blocks 2 then 1 teeing off from hole 10 and blocks 3 then 4 teeing off from hole 1.

The 2nd round will start in reverse order to the 1st round and from a different starting hole.

The 3rd and 4th rounds will start in reverse order of the cumulative results of the first 2 rounds and from a different starting hole.

### **Article 9 - PRIZE-GIVING**

The top 2 finishers in the Coupe Patrick Frayssineau and the top 3 finishers in the Coupe Mouchy will be awarded prizes.

### **Article 10 - PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY**

Sunday 26 April 2026 at the end of the 4th round, by Marc PANDRAU, President of Golf de Fontainebleau. The prize-giving ceremony will be followed by a cocktail reception.

The Event Committee reserves the right to modify the form of play, to cancel the event or to have it played on fewer days than provided for in the special regulations.

### **Article 12 - DRESS CODE**

The dress code used at Fontainebleau Golf Club must be respected:

- do not wear blue jeans, jogging suits, long pants with tights, short shorts or a T-shirt without a collar or sleeves.
- soft-spikes are compulsory throughout the tournament.
- use of mobile phones inside the club house is prohibited.
